



MR. JEFFREY NOBLE, FCMA

A UK national with over 25 years senior management experience in high technology businesses, Mr. Noble is a fully qualified UK chartered accountant and a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Management Accountants (FCMA).

From 1999 to 2010, he worked for Millicom International Cellular SA, a global mobiletelecommunications network operator which operates 13 cellular operations worldwide in developing markets (market capitalization approx USD 10 billion) and is part of the Investments Kinnevik AB Group of Sweden.

From 2005 to 2010 Mr. Noble served as Chief Executive Officer for Comvik International Vietnam AB, Millicom's subsidiary in Vietnam, which operated Vietnam's largest mobile network, Mobifone, in partnership with the Vietnam Mobile Services Company. He was also CEO of the Group's Cambodian mobile network, CamGSM, as well as holding directorships in several of the Groups other Asian regional companies.

Mr. Noble served on the Executive Committee of the European Chamber of Commerce in Vietnam from 2004 to 2010, assisting the European business community in Vietnam on investment decisions, legislation advice, lobbying activities and Business-to-Government (B2G) relations.

Mr. Noble has wide international experience, having lived and worked in locations including Saudi Arabia, Lebanon, Tanzania, several Caribbean nations, China, Indonesia, South Korea, Vietnam and Cambodia. He has management experience in businesses at all stages of development, from start-ups to established market leaders, and has been a lead figure in a number of merger and acquisition deals, an Initial Public Offering (IPO) and several major financing deals.

Mr. Noble is currently serving as Chief Operating Officer of Royal Falcon Fleet plc.
