After graduating in 1968 as a Mechanical Engineer, Mr. Björn Rosengren began his professional career as a Technical Officer in the National Road Administration. His leadership qualities gained him various positions in the Swedish government over the years such as: Chairman of the Salaried Local Government Employees' Federation (SKTF) 1976-1982; President of the Confederation of Professional Employees (TCO) 1982-1994; Governor for the county of Norrbotten Province 1995-1998; Minister of Industry, Employment, Communications & Energy 1998-2002; Member of Parliament 2002. He is active in the labour union and a is Social Democratic politician.

He currently holds the position of a Senior Advisor in the Kinnevik Group of Sweden and also serves as a member in Board of Advisors for Royal Falcon Fleet.
